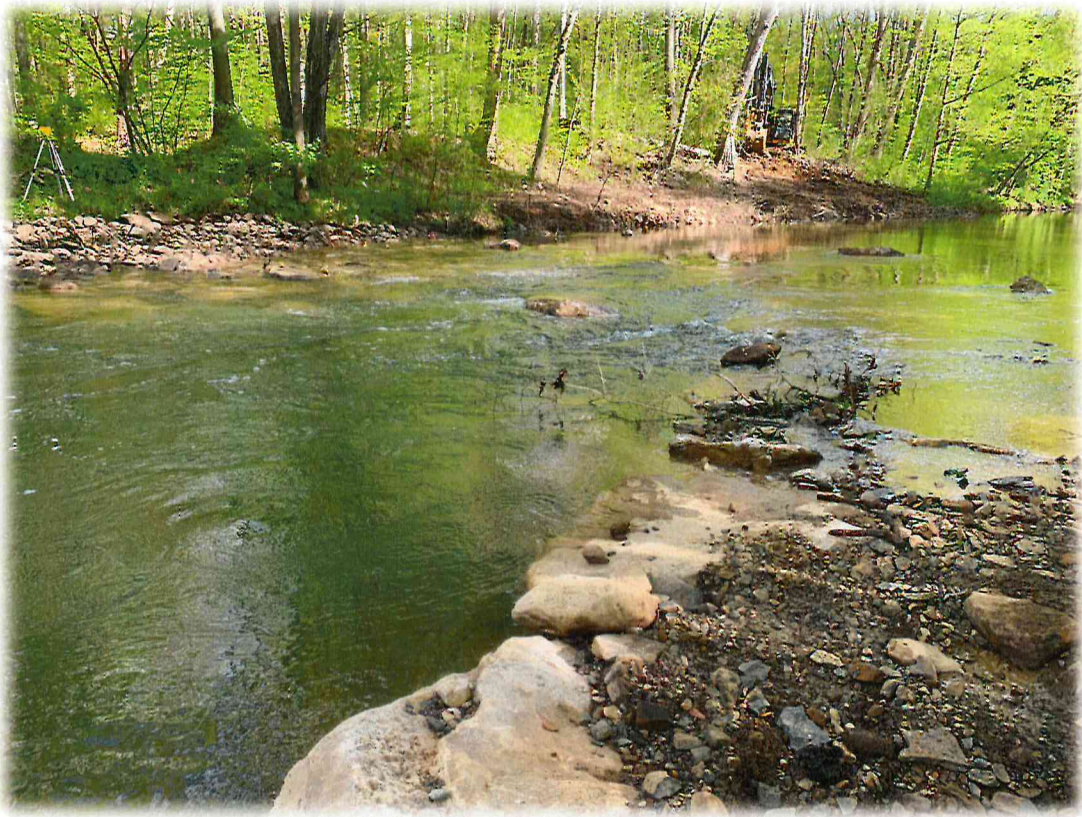

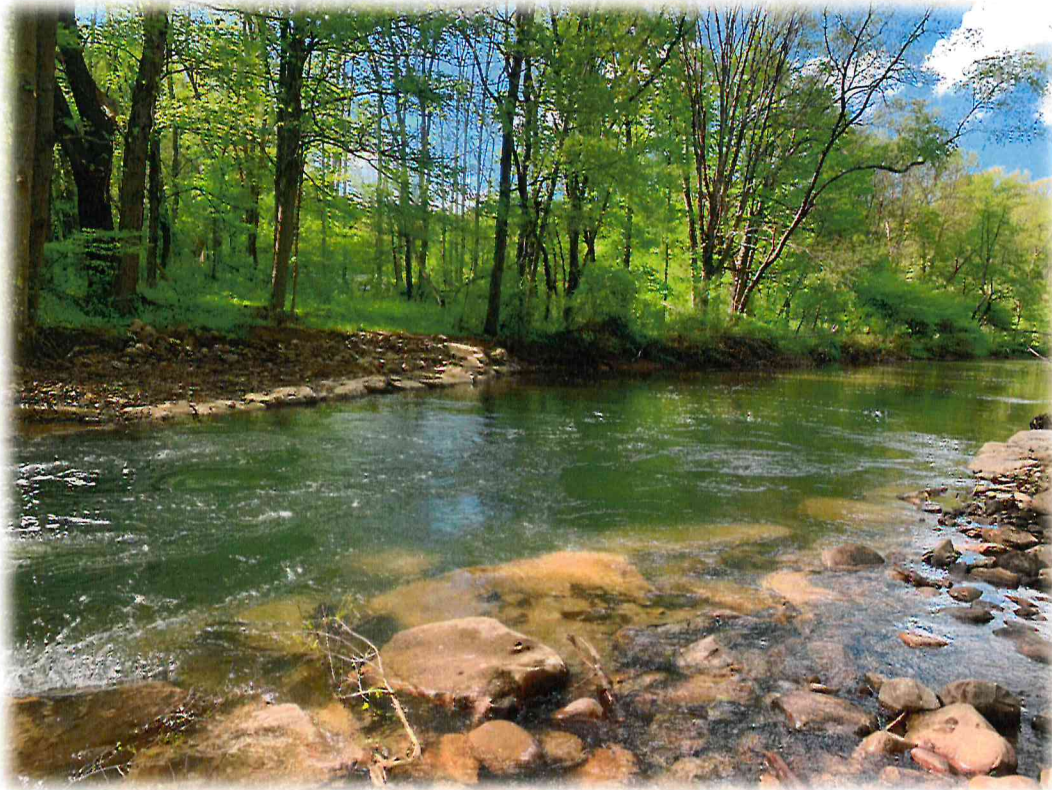
Screened river rock being placed in Quemahoning Creek to create riffle habitat.



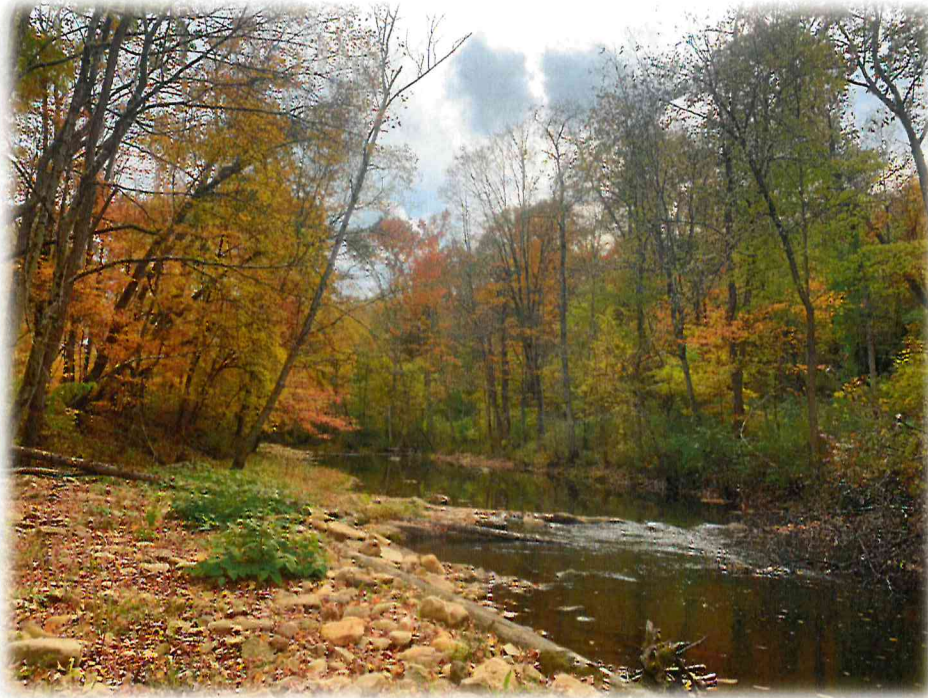
Boulders being placed in the stream for the construction of a rock cross vane.
